This role reports to the Alpine Director. It is a full-time role based at home and remotely with the team.

- To support structured training and competition plans, both on and off snow and to optimise physical and technical training for each athlete.

- To maintain a safe and positive team culture.
- To help athletes understand GBS expectations of athlete conduct, character and team cohesion.
